Next Week Retiring Collection White Flower Appeal, held outside of church ~ People often ask why our annual appeal is called the 'White Flower' and what that means. The origins of the name were actually inspired by the work of the Weiße Rose (White Rose) movement, a non-violent, intellectual resistance in Germany at the height of the Second World War. They became known for an anonymous leafleting and graffiti campaign that lasted 8 months between 1942 and 1943.

In February 1943 Hans and Sophie Scholl, two of the group's core active members were caught and arrested. Following interrogation, they were tried by the Gestapo and beheaded along with four others. The White Rose and Sophie Scholl have been the subject of a number of films retelling the story of their bravery to new generations. The White Rose still serves as an example to us of what can be achieved by standing up for what is right peacefully but with determination, even in the face of hostility and oppression.

The World Day of Prayer this year will be on **Friday 1st March.** It is an international, inter-church organisation, the service being prepared in a different part of the world each year. It is estimated that 3 million people in more than 170 countries will gather to observe the Day of Prayer, which comes this year from **Slovenia.** In the British Isles over 5,000 services will be held.

In Woodstock, at the Baptist Church, 5a High Street, OX20 1TA, there will be two services:

- 11.00a.m. for children from Year 5, Woodstock Primary
 School and from Year 7, the Marlborough School
- 7.00p.m. ecumenical service with the theme 'Come Everything is Ready!'

Everyone is warmly invited to either or both services; parents, grandparents and friends are welcome to attend at 11.00a.m.; adults, especially those at work during the day, are welcome to attend at 7.00p.m.

Friday, 1st March at 7pm. The service has been carefully prepared in Slovenia and you are all invited to join fellow christians pray together for Freedom, Justice and Peace.
