Easter Psalter Weeks 1 & 2

Dear All, At the Parish Assembly meeting on the 25th February 2024 there was a discussion about the parish's finances. Attendees emphasized the importance to inform all parishioners about the running cost of the parish and explore ways to improve contributions, and also brainstormed ideas to raise funds to improve the situation.

Some ideas proposed were:

- Encouraging parishioners who are already gift aiding their collection to consider increasing their contributions (50 pence to £1 a week) if they are able to do so .
 - Encouraging all parishioners who pay any UK income tax or capital gains tax to participate in gift aid. (Gift Aid forms are available at the back of each Church). It was noted that £22,000 was not gift aided on collections last year, but not everyone may be aware that they are eligible.
 - Open call for fundraising suggestions : the Parish Assembly invited parishioners to share any ideas that they had to increase the parish finances. Fund raising activity for 2023 raised £6,698.13
 - INCOMING REVENUE £123,000 included in this figure is £14,000 in legacies.
 - RUNNING COSTS OF THE PARISH for last year was £109,000
 - The diocese as a policy caps the interest charges on debt at 2%. This is good news, but even with such a reduction the monthly interest on our debt is over £ 800 per month.
 - **STM – Hall:** Parish Volunteer Ian Drury manages the hall to the best he could, primarily for the parish use and is open for the wider parish's and public's reasonable use. Challenges faced are: no proper entrance unless through school car park. The lower ceiling and the availability of the spaces, restricts the demand for it raising health, safety and safeguarding risks. Parish is indebted to Ian, also to Lou Borucki for ready help.
 - **STH -Centre:** Parish Volunteer Ruth Fiddy manages to the best she could and has raised by way of hiring £21,770 for 2023. It is important to note that only so much could be raised by way of hiring. It is used to the best it could during the weekdays. During the weekends it could do with a bit of help in promoting, taking booking and manage the hall. Ruth would welcome some help for the weekends. We need to manage the bookings and the use of hall, reasonably taking to consideration the wear and tear. In this manner the use of the hall on weekends can be increased and so raise the income from hiring. Parish is indebted to Ruth.
 - The expenditure on maintenance and the interest on debt creates a shortfall on our target of raising £30,000 towards paying the debt. Parish needs your ideas, initiatives and support in every way you could.
