LIVE STREAMING CONSENT FORM

Please complete this form if you are requesting your mass service be available online for longer than 3 months.

We recognise that benefits of our mass services being live streamed, especially if you have relatives or friends who cannot attend a baptism, wedding or funeral to engage with it. However we only keep web streamed content online for 3 months, because it is considered to be an intrusion into your privacy if the content is available for some time over the internet.

When our mass services are made available live over the internet, or available online after a service, the images can be accessed anyone, anywhere in the world. Some people who view the images on the internet may be able to record and keep them and the Parish has no control over how such images may be used.

Those who do not wish to have their image live streamed are advised **to go to the cry room (the family room separated by glass panel, and let Priest know that you need communion brought to you).**
